The Board viewed the old hospital building with Fred Kuchinski of the County Building Maintenance.

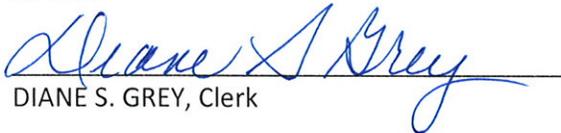
