

Safety Meeting

February 2014

The meeting was called to order by safety Adviser Ruth Koehler. Those in attendance were: Fred Kuchinski, Duane Hoxworth, Eugene Wallace, Jules Waber, Broudie Loushin, Gary Larson, Sandra Lowney, Rem Mannix.

Safety Adviser Koehler told the committee that the Commissioners had approved the Hazard Communication Policy, Hearing Conservation Policy and the Bloodborne Pathogens Policy. Brodie will send Ruth the name of a company that has a mobile audiometric testing lab for our base line hearing tests.

The committee took a few minutes to review the first 20 pages of the proposed safety Manual. Discussion followed on the Hepatitis Vaccine program and blood titers for those that don't have access to their records. The vaccine is covered under the county insurance, but the blood titer if necessary has a 20% copay after you have met your deductible.

Ruth handed out monthly safety sheets and vaccination declination sheets to the road crew supervisors. She also asked for a PPE inventory from the 3 road shops. Districts #1 and #3 completed theirs on site, District #2 will send his back later.

Ruth will continue to work on a new employee orientation program.
