Value of Animals Purchased/Owned/Possessed

Beginning

1. How much did you pay for your hog(s)? Can you show me that from your records?
2. How many hogs did you purchase and why?
3. What is the breed of your hog(s) and what are the characteristics of that breed?

Intermediate

4. If your hog is home raised and not purchased, what value would you place on it, and why?
5. Please point out in your records how much you purchased your hog for and if it was on a per pound basis or per head basis?
6. Why did you select this specific breeding for your hog? What characteristics were you looking for when you picked your animal?
7. If you could improve your animal, what would it be and why?

Advanced

8. What is an F1 cross?
9. Please provide from your records when you purchased your animal, from whom you purchased it from and what the hog's weight when purchased?
11. How does knowing the frame type of your hog assist in completing your project?
12. What other important characteristics help to determine if you have a show quality animal.

Value of Animals Owned at End of Project

1. What have you determined to be the appropriate ending weight for your hog(s)?
2. What is the ideal ending weight for a market hog?
3. What is a by-product from your project animal?

Intermediate

Advanced

5. What do you estimate the market value of your hog will be per pound at the end of your project?
6. At the estimated market price for your hog, what will be the total cash value of your hog at the end of your project?

1. From your records please show me what kind of feed you are feeding your hog and how much?

3. From your records how much did each of your feeds cost per pound?
4. From your records how much have you spent on feed to date for your project?
5. If your feed is raised or mixed in your own ration at home and not purchased, what is the value of your feed per pound?
6. Why is it important to have consistent feeding times for your hog throughout the project?

Intermediate

7. Is your hog a ruminant or mono-gastric animal?
8. What are some examples of feed ingredients that are classified as proteins?
9. What are some examples of feed ingredients that are classified as energy?
10. What is the most essential nutrient for your hog and also the cheapest of all nutrients?
11. Calcium is an important to build what in your hogs?

Advanced

12. What is the advantage of a mono-gastric digestive system?
13. Amino Acids help hogs in the formation of what?
14. From your feed tag what is the percent of Crude protein?
15. What are the five fundamental nutritional requirements of your hog?

9. What is a feed conversion ratio?

11. Generally, does a mono-gastric animal have a higher or lower feed conversion ratio compared to a ruminant animal?

Intermediate

Advanced

8. Given the price you expect to receive for your hog, what is the cost per pound the purchaser will pay for the finished product that goes into the freezer?
9. What three genes affect muscle quality and can be important to the quality of the product you sell the consumer.

Expenses other than Feed

Beginning & Intermediate

1. Did you borrow money to purchase your hog?
