### ARROWSTONE PARK BOARD TRAILS SUBCOMMITTEE

The Trails Sub-Committee Met in regular session on Wednesday, August 23, 10:30 AM in the Deer Lodge Medical Center's Conference Room.

#### Agenda Item #1 – Call to Order

Chair Duncan called the meeting to order at 10:33 AM.

Chair Duncan acknowledged there is a quorum with the presence of five members.

#### Agenda Item #2 – Approval of Minutes

#### Agenda Item #3 – The Corner Bar North Mural Update

The wall is now painted to match the upper portion of the wall. It looks great. (G.Swant)  
Purchase of the property along the proposed mural wall is back to a no-go with Bernard Mues and son. This changes weekly. It was suggested we move forward with other mural/park area considerations at this point in time. Acquisition of the Town Pump sign is completed by the Chamber and Park Board. Member Gary Swant suggested

this as a mural “potential”.

A gifted 1.5 acre piece on the southwest side of the Milwaukee Avenue Bridge may serve as community orientation site park.

**Agenda Item #4– Old Milwaukee Railroad property Update**

Prior to the meeting Carl Hamming provided an update:

The property is “on track”. ESA and languaging of a purchase agreement by Lewis Smith is in process. NRD monies earlier allotted to the development of Trestle Park are available for the purchase of the old Milwaukee railroad bed.

Gary Swant shared that a person has expressed that his land at the trail end north could serve as parking lot availability. More discussion revealed the two closed interstate rest stops as a recycle source for signage, tables, etc.

Day use developments south of town at Racetrack Pond may increase public interest in developing a trail south. Never give up!

**Agenda Item #5 – Chilcott/Jaycee Park Trail - AARP**

A recent unofficial announcement regarding an AARP Challenge Project grant submitted by Carl Hamming will provide \$4500 for completion of a primitive trail to close the gap from Indian Creek Campground to Jaycee Park area. The project completion date is November 1 so this will need to be a high focus area. \$4100 for the engineering and permitting costs of the trail concept has already been allocated by the County.
