

2022 FOOD AWARD

Open to any 4-Her meeting the requirements

Previously completed Cooking 101 **OR** Baking 101 **AND** 1 other project from Foods & Nutrition (Not Cooking 101 or Baking 101)

Currently enrolled in food project(s), (must be Cooking or Baking level different than previously completed)

Entries at Fair: Enter at least 8 (eight) 4-H food entries. Must receive Blue ribbon or above on 8 (eight) entries

Need to apply for award Letter of intent to apply for the award listing your qualifications for the award must be **submitted with Fair entry form**

Must be interviewed by foods judges at the Fair—call Powell County Extension office (846-9708) to set up interview time

- 4-H Record Forms in the Foods area must be presented at time of interview. Must be complete Food project records of all years enrolled in Foods projects
- Must show growth in project
- Participation in county events pertaining to food project highly recommended
- Member may receive this award only once
- If requirements are not met to the satisfaction of the judges, this award will not be given

2022 BILLQUIST FAMILY SEWING EXCELLENCE AWARD

This award has two tracks—you may enter either in sewing OR quilting

Open to any 4-Her meeting the requirements

Must have completed Sewing 1 (for those in sewing track) **OR** Beginning Quilting (for those in the quilting track)

Need to apply for award Letter of intent to apply for the award listing your qualifications for the award must be **submitted with Fair entry form**

Entries at Fair: **For the Sewing Track:** enter at least 4 (four) sewn lot numbers in 4-H Sewing 2, Advanced Sewing, or Independent Study. One lot number may be from Quilting Intermediate, Advanced, or Independent Study. Four (4) lot numbers must be blue ribbon quality or above.

For the Quilting Project: enter at least 4 (four) sewn quilting lot numbers in 4-H Quilting Intermediate, Advanced, or Independent Study. One lot number may be from Sewing 2, Advanced Sewing, or Independent Study. One item must be a quilt of at least twin size. Four (4) entries must be blue ribbon quality or above.

Must have a 30 minute interview at the Fair with both judges present—schedule your interview time early so that we don't have to change around too many other interview times to fit in your extended interview time with both judges

- 4-H Record Forms for all years enrolled in the sewing and quilting projects must be up-to-date and submitted to judges by 9:00 a.m. on date of judging
- Must show growth in project
- Member may only receive this award once
- If requirements are not met to the satisfaction of the judges, this award will not be given
