



Notice of Close of Regular Voter Registration and Option for Late Registration

For all elections, this notice must be published by the election administrator specifying the day regular registrations will close and the availability of the late registration option provided for in 13-2-304 in a newspaper of general circulation in the county at least three times in the 4 weeks preceding the close of registration or broadcast a notice on radio or television as provided in 2-3-105 through 2-3-107, using the method the election administrator believes is best suited to reach the largest number of potential electors.

NOTICE TO BE FILED WITH NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN COUNTY OR BROADCAST A NOTICE ON RADIO OR TELEVISION PURSUANT TO 13-2-301

Notice is hereby given that regular* registration for the Federal General Election to be held on November 8, 2022 will close at 5:00 p.m., on October 11, 2022.

**NOTE: If you miss this regular registration deadline (30 days prior to the election), you may still late register at the county election office. The late registration certificate may be exchanged for a ballot at the election office until the close of polls on Election Day. The county election office is located at 409 Missouri Ave, Suite 203, Deer Lodge, MT.*

All active and inactive**electors of Powell County, MT are entitled to vote at said election.

**Inactive electors may reactivate by appearing at the polling place in order to vote, by requesting an absentee ballot in any election, or by notifying the County Election Administrator in writing of the elector's current address in the county.

Persons who wish to register and who are not presently registered may do so by submitting a form for registration by mail or by appearing at the county election office. If you have moved, please update your registration information by filling out a new voter registration form and submitting it to the county election office.
